


Children & Caregivers

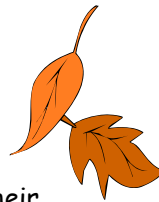
Join us for a fun, playful experience. Children and their caregivers participate in stories, fingerplays, action rhymes, and more.
