


Getting Started Downloading e-audio and eBooks using the Kobo Vox



Getting started

1. Start the Kobo Vox and connect to a wireless network. To do this go to: Home → All Apps → Settings → Wireless & Networks. Touch the checkbox next to Wi-Fi Settings and choose an available network
2. Before you can download the necessary app you will need to establish an Adobe ID. To do this go to: www.adobe.com/membership. Please make note of the ID and password you create
3. Download the Overdrive Media Console app at <http://www.overdrive.com/software/omc/>. Go to Mobile Apps at the bottom right of screen Overdrive will recognize that the device is an Android device and will provide a link to the Android Market. The Vox cannot connect to the Android Market so you will need to choose the link that says "If your device doesn't support Android Market, you can download OverDrive Media Console for Android from OverDrive"
4. When the license agreement appears, choose "I Agree". The app will begin to download.
5. At the "Home" screen go to All Apps → Downloads → ODMediaConsoleSetup.apk
6. Select "Install". OverDrive Media will be installed.
7. Click on the middle button of your device  and go to **Get Books**.
8. At this point you should be able to "select a library". Choose "Waterloo Public Library" → Download Library

Search for and download titles

1. There are several ways to peruse the collection. You can search for specific titles and authors or browse by genre. To search only for titles that are currently available go to the Advanced Search and choose "Adobe EPUB ebooks" from the format menu and choose a "Subject" that appeals to you. Check the box next to "Only show titles with copies available". Your search will show a list of results that are currently available. If you are searching for available audio books choose "Overdrive MP3 Audiobook" from the drop-down menu.
2. After you have added an available title to your cart, select "Proceed to Checkout". Select "Waterloo Public Library) from the drop-down menu. Login by entering your library card number and PIN (last 4 digits of your phone number). Select your preferred loan period using the drop-down menu. Select "Confirm check-out".
3. You can now download the title using the "Download" button under the item. The title will automatically download and open in the Overdrive Media Console Mobile app on your device. You will be prompted to enter your Adobe ID and password in order to authorize your device.

A few things to note:

- WMA audiobooks cannot be downloaded to a mobile device
- eBooks and audiobooks cannot be renewed although an item can be signed out again for an addition loan period if there are no holds pending on it
- there is a limit of 15 items total that can be signed out at one time
- eBooks can be returned prior to due date however audiobooks cannot be returned early
