

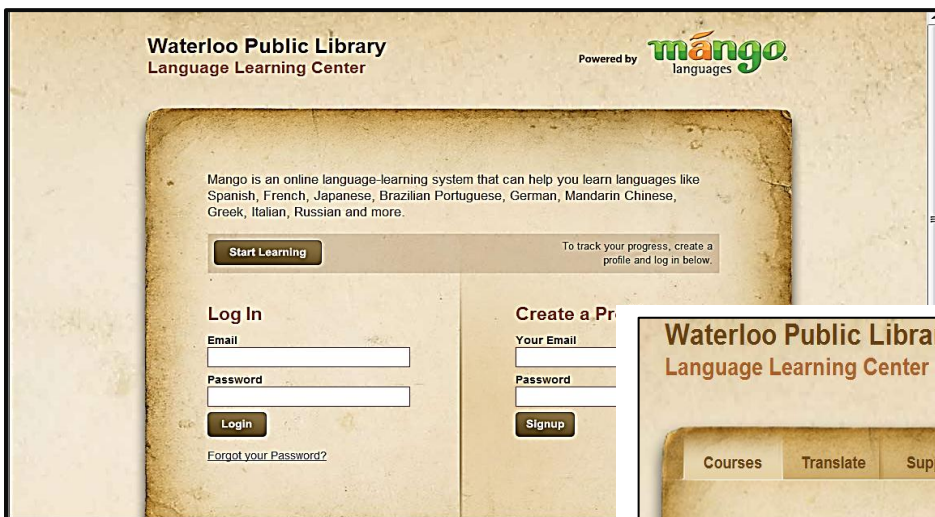
# Mango Languages

Create a Profile (optional) if you would like to track your progress through a course taken over several days or skip the Login and go to **Start Learning**.

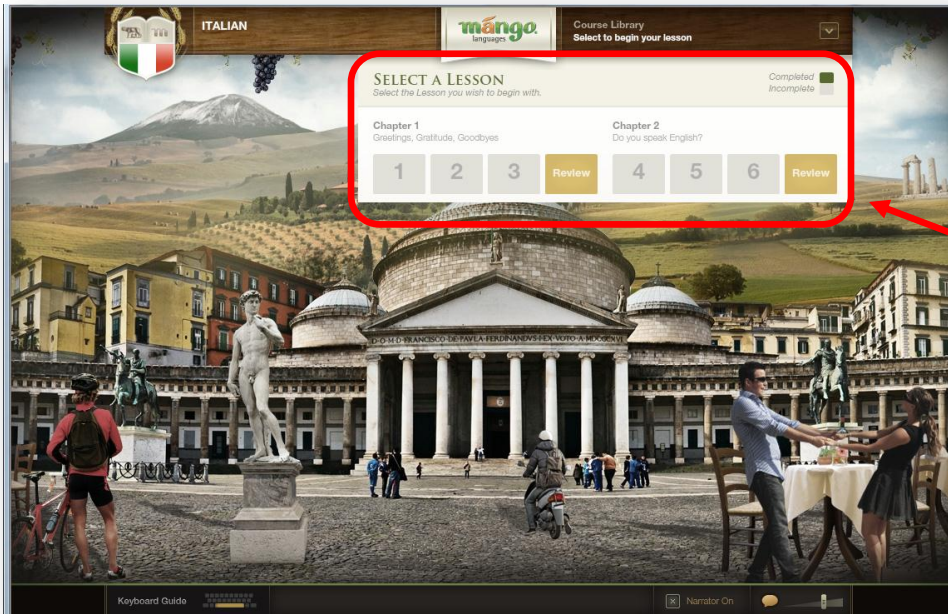
Select the language and course level you want to learn.



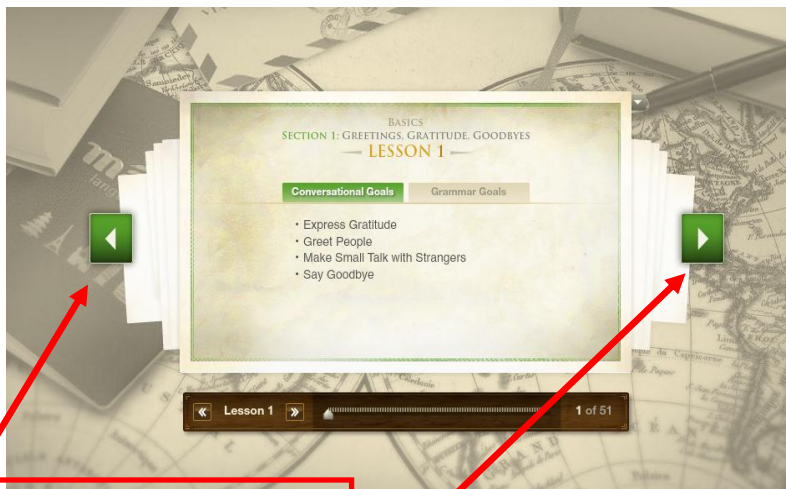

# Basic Course



Select the lesson you would like to begin on



Review the Conversational and Grammar goals of the lesson.  
Click on the arrow when you are ready to begin the lesson

The button on your left is the Pronunciation button. The button on the right is the Voice Comparison. You will need to use a microphone to utilize this feature.



Be sure to have the volume of your computer turned on (use headphones if you are in the library). Listen to the conversation.

Click the Fluency Button to hear the word pronounced at normal speaking speed

After the narrator reads a slide, the Voice Comparison Button will appear. Click it to compare your pronunciation to that of the narrator

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## Questions to try yourself:

1. List five language courses offered through Mango that has both a Basic and a Complete course available.
2. How many ESL language courses are offered through Mango? (you don't need to list them).
3. Find a language you are interested in learning. Select the first lesson from the course menu. Proceed through the entire first lesson. You will need to use a headphone or headset if you are accessing the lesson from a library computer. (I have two headsets at my desk that can be borrowed).
  - a. Which language did you begin learning?
  - b. Did you find the narrator easy to understand?
  - c. Did you find the Cultural Notes included in the lesson to be interesting/helpful?
  - d. Now that you have used Mango yourself, do you feel more confident recommending it to others?
