

Newspapers and Magazine articles

Many newspapers and magazines provide online access to some or all of their current content on their websites. Archived issues of these same newspapers and magazines are often not freely available on the website. However, you can easily access archived articles through several of the library's databases including **eLibrary Canada** and **MasterFILE Premier**.

For example, you are looking for an article that appeared in last Saturday's Waterloo Region Record newspaper. You can see a complete list of all the articles from that day's newspaper in the **eLibrary Canada** database.

To see a complete list of publications select a media format icon. Choose the first letter of the publication's name. From the alphabetical list select the publication title you want.




Browse publication by date. Click on the date to see a complete list of articles.

Using the **eLibrary Canada** database, please answer the following:

1. Is the National Post newspaper included in the **eLibrary Canada** database?
 - Go to Publications tab at top of screen
 - Select the Newspaper icon
 - In the alphabetical list of Newspapers go to “N” for National Post
2. The transcripts for 60 Minutes are included in the **eLibrary Canada** database. What is the subject of the 60 Minutes program that aired on May 16th?
 - From the eLibrary Canada homepage click on the Transcripts icon
 - From the alphabetical list of programs, go to 60 Minutes (it is in the 0-9 category)
 - Refine by date
3. List several library-related publications included in the **eLibrary Canada** database.
 - Go to Publications tab at top of screen
 - In the Find Publications box type “library”

Using the **MaterFILE Premier** database, please answer the following:

1. How many publications including in this database begin with the word “Ontario”?
 - Click on the Publications tab in the upper-left side of the screen
 - From the Alphabetical list, select “O”
 - Browse through the list of “O” publications searching for titles beginning with “Ontario”
2. How far back is *AARP: The Magazine* archived?
3. Browse through the list of publications and search for 10 publications that you weren’t previously familiar with that you may find useful in the future.
