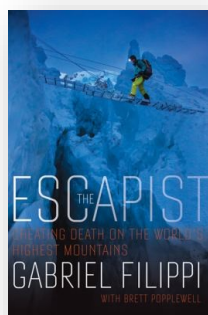


### Nutshell by Ian McEwan

Ian McEwan startles and delights his devoted readers with this brief tale of murder and revenge that shares themes in common with Hamlet and is told with wit and panache. ### The Escapist by Gabriel Filippi

Well aware that there were at least seventeen ways that he could die that evening, Gabriel Filippi left his tent to face the mountain. In this biography, *The Escapist*, Canada's foremost mountaineer's multiple escapes from death are well narrated. Evading avalanches, Taliban attacks and oxygen deprivation, Filippi failed to avoid PTSD and survivor's guilt. Burdened by how to move forward while his friend's bodies were left on peaks, Filippi writes openly about his depression and the risks he continually takes. *The Escapist* is an excellent read for armchair adventurers, and for those who want to gain a better understanding of sports and survivor psychology.
