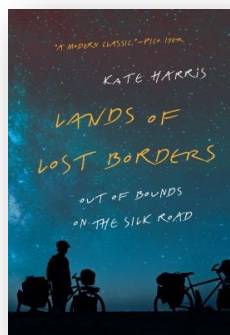
Featured Fiction Books
