Aquatics Volunteers: City of Waterloo Swim Programs

Shopper Escort:

Drive a senior in your vehicle to the grocery store, assist with shopping and help put groceries away. Must have valid G license, a reliable vehicle, safe driving record and meet screening requirements.

List Shopper:

Pick up groceries, deliver them and help put them away. Must have a reliable vehicle and meet screening requirements.

Drivers for Senior Outing Day Program: One scheduled hour per week – morning or afternoon. Mileage Reimbursed

The Senior Outing Day Program at the Adult Recreation Centre provides much needed social and recreational programs to Waterloo seniors. Must be a caring, experienced driver with a reliable vehicle and pass all screening requirements.

Activity Assistant, Senior Outing Day Program: Monday or Friday afternoon

Make a difference by socializing and interacting with local seniors. Welcome participants, prepare coffee, serve refreshments and assist with planned activities at the Adult Rec. Centre.

Kitchen Helper for Senior's Lunch Program, Tuesday or Thursday 9am to 1:30pm

Assist with food preparation, set tables, serve lunch and clear tables at the Adult Recreation Centre. Must be a dependable adult with excellent communication skills and able to work in a fast paced environment. Lunch is provided!
